**A program of scientific visits** to companies and institutes specialized in the field of marine resources

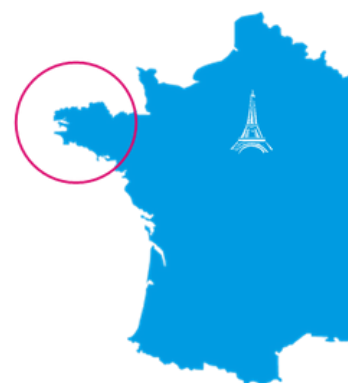
**A program of cultural visits** to discover the attractions of the Brittany region

##### Le Cèdre, against marine pollution

At Le Cèdre, a non-profit organization set up after the Amoco Cadiz oil spill (1974), specialists will explain how they are working to improve France's ability to respond to oil spills and other pollution, and how they are responding to marine environmental disasters around the world
